Dear OAA Members –

- The next **Chamber show** goes up on Friday March 16th, bring your work to the Presbyterian Church on Park Blvd. between 10 am and 11am. Ross Drago will be our judge – the updated rule sheet is attached.
- Roughly two weeks later, on Thursday March 29th, OAA will hang the **2018 Photo and Digital Media show** at the Alameda County Law Library – the rules sheet is attached.
 - As an artist you have is an extraordinary gift which translates into a talent for telling stories and conveying emotion with images. Your talent shows in every photograph you take, whether with an iPhone or an expensive camera. Please share your favorite images in this show – you’re probably a great photographer even if you haven’t thought much about it!
 - The take-in/show is on Thursday because the Library is closed on Good Friday.
 - Because this show is only up for a month, entry fees have been reduced to \$4.
- These next two shows in March will be the last juried shows until mid-June (full 2018 schedule is attached). Last chance for a while to enter your art, and to volunteer your help to make these shows a reality.

RECEIVING: Friday March 16th, 2018 from 10 AM until 11AM at the Presbyterian Church, 4101 Park Blvd., Oakland. Enter parking lot from Hampel Street.

JUROR: Ross Drago

ACCEPTED WORKS: Pick up at 10am on a Friday June 15th, 2018 at the Presbyterian Church.

ENTRIES: Up to 2 entries will be accepted per member. Entries will be two dimensional; 12"x 12" min. and 36"x 36" max. - nominal size including mats.

Artworks depicting iconic scenes of San Francisco are not appropriate for this venue! If entered, artwork in this category may be rejected at the sole discretion of the show chairman.

Because only 7 "large" (i.e. over 24"X30") works can be displayed in the show space, only the first 7 "large" pieces will be accepted, unless specifically allowed by the Show Chair.

Works restricted to original work – no class work or copies. Nudes and political statements are not accepted (venue requirement). All work must be for sale. The Chamber reserves the right to reject any work from the show for any reason.

Any work shown at a Chamber of Commerce Show **prior to** December 2012 may be shown again at this show. Any work having won a cash award in any OAA show is not eligible to receive another cash award but may receive a merit award.

To be entered as a single work, any grouping of 2 or more works must be mounted within a single frame which meets the overall size requirements.

ENTRY FEE: \$8.00 per entry.

FRAMING: No wide (may not exceed 3") or elaborate frames will be accepted.

Mats must be clean and well cut and frames must be clean, sturdy and no protruding screw eyes or "saw tooth" hangers will be allowed.

Works larger than 24" x 30" (if covered) must be under plastic instead of glass.

Entry Forms: Must be filled out completely and affixed to the upper left hand corner on the back of the entry.

PLEASE TYPE OR PRINT LEGIBLY!

AWARDS: First award \$100; Second award \$50; Third award \$25. Merit awards are given at the discretion of the Juror.

INSURANCE: A waiver must be signed on receiving day.

SALES:

All sales made during the show and/or 30days following the close of the show (if the work was seen by the buyer at the show) will be handled by the Sales Chairman Tina Nelson rixin2@aol.com or 925 256-6849.

Up to 4 entries accepted per member.

Works restricted to original work.

All work must be for sale.

To be entered as a single work, any grouping of 2 or more works must be mounted within a single frame which meets the overall size requirements.

ENTRY FEE: \$4.00 per entry.

FRAMING: Frames and mats must be clean, well cut, and sturdy.

Entry Forms: Must be filled out completely and affixed to the upper left-hand corner on the back of the entry.

AWARDS: First award \$100; Second award \$50; Third award \$25. Merit awards are given at the discretion of the Juror.

INSURANCE: Each artist will be required to sign the normal OAA insurance.

SALES:

All sales made during the show and/or 30days following the close of the show (if the work was seen by the buyer at the show) will be handled by the Sales Chair (Tina Nelson 925 256-6849).

OAA policy is that no change will be made in the price (in connection with this show) after the work is accepted. The artist agrees that 30% of the sale price will be taken as a contribution to OAA. Sales tax of 9.25% will be added to all sales.

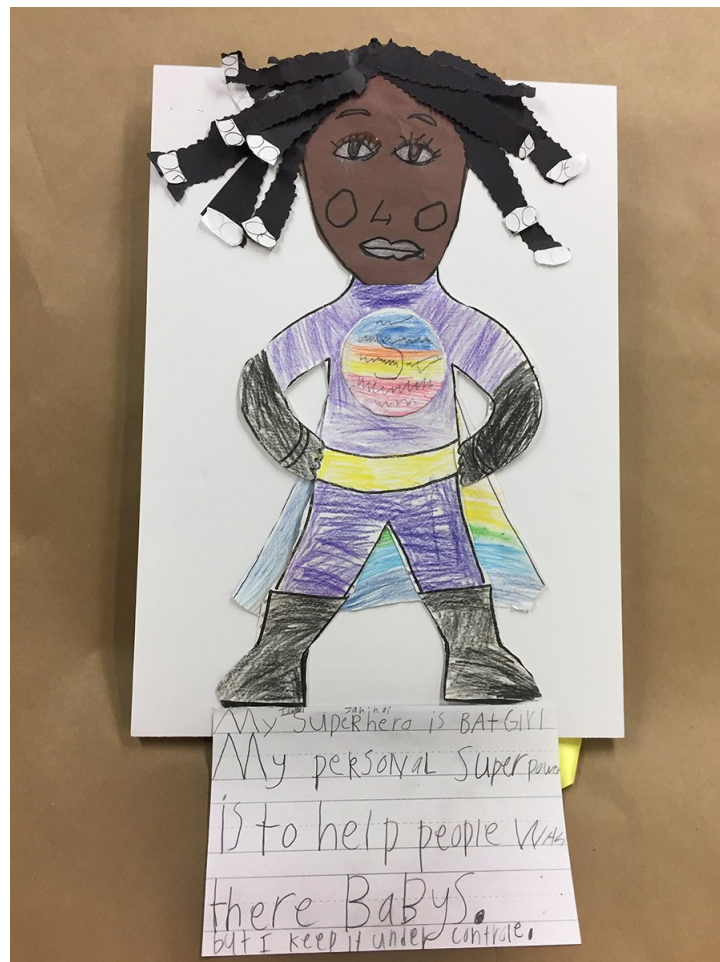

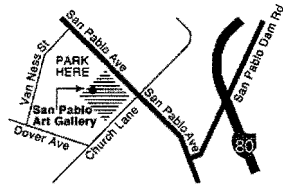
