Stan Cohen

We were all saddened to hear of Stan Cohen's passing on the 8th of January. I'm among a large group of people who have been privileged in knowing Stan and Naomi. A number of us painted together with Stan every Monday at the North Berkeley Senior Center and every Wednesday at the Kensington Community Center for several years. He wasn't officially our teacher but we regarded him as a mentor and we came to know him well. We are grateful for the time Stan gave us. He

had advice when we sought it, and during our art critiques, he always chose the most positive way of auiding us on how we could improve. He told us many stories of his adventures in life, and he listened to ours with enthusiasm. I thought I would summarize Stan's backaround in his own words.

> I have always known that art would be my life's work. My parents openly worried

that my path would be difficult, but I have seldom doubted my early choice.

My wife and I met at the High School of Music and Art in New York City and married a year after graduation. Naomi has been supportive of my work throughout our 64 years of marriage. We both were teachers in the Oakland Public Schools and I later was appointed director of art for the School District.

ACCEPTED WORKS: Pick up at the Presbyterian Church on April 25th, 2014 between 10 AM and 11 AM.

ENTRIES: Up to 2 entries will be accepted per member. Entries will be two dimensional; 12"x 12" min. and 36"x 36" max. - nominal size including mats.

Artworks depicting iconic scenes of San Francisco are not appropriate for this venue! If entered, artwork in this category may be rejected at the sole discretion of the show chairman.

Because only 7 "large" (i.e. over 24"X30") works can be displayed in the show space, only the first 7 "large" pieces will be accepted, unless specifically allowed by the Show Chair.

Works restricted to original work – no class work or copies. Nudes and political statements are not accepted (venue requirement). All work must be for sale. The Chamber reserves the right to reject any work from the show for any reason.

Any work shown at a Chamber of Commerce Show **prior to** August 2010 may be shown again at this show. Any work having won a cash award in any OAA show is not eligible to receive another cash award but may receive a merit award.

To be entered as a single work, any grouping of 2 or more works must be mounted within a single frame which meets the overall size requirements.

ENTRY FEE: \$8.00 per entry.

FRAMING: No wide (may not exceed 3") or elaborate frames will be accepted.

Mats must be clean and well cut and frames must be clean, sturdy and no protruding screw eyes or hangers will be allowed.

Works larger than 24" x 30" (if covered) must be under plastic instead of glass.

Entry Forms: Must be filled out completely and affixed to the upper left hand corner on the back of the entry.

PLEASE TYPE OR PRINT LEGIBLY!

AWARDS: First award \$125; Second award \$75; Third award \$50. Merit awards are given at the discretion of the Juror.

INSURANCE: A waiver must be signed on receiving day.

All work having won cash awards in any OAA show are not eligible to receive another cash award, but may receive a merit award.

To be entered as a single work, any grouping of 2 or more works must be mounted within a single frame which meets the overall size requirements.


