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Newsletter and Email Updates:

Welcome to the first quarterly newsletter published by the Oakland Art Association! As you may recall, the board of directors decided back in June that since all our active members seem comfortable with electronic medium, information and updates about our normal activities would be more timely and just as effective if delivered through periodic emails. The last monthly newsletter

was published in July, which has been followed by three "What's Happening" email updates at times specific to OAA shows and events. The published newsletters will continue to provide the relevant dates, times and places as they are known at the time, but the "What's Happening" emails will be a more accurate and timely source of this information. The hope is that this quarterly

"newsletter" will evolve to cover a more general overview of our members and the Association's direction and progress in months and years to come.

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A light Calendar Until Next March:

The flurry of Oakland Art Association shows in the summer and fall have ended, and we have a bit of a dry spell ahead. There's one more juried show in 2016, the Oakland Chamber show at 10am on Friday December 9th -- the rules

are on page 4 of the newsletter. The juried show schedule picks up again in March with both a new Chamber show and the John Muir Hospital Show— see page 2.

The OAA Board will meet in early December (watch your email for the exact date/ location/time), combining the November and December meetings.

Alameda County Law Library Venue:

Several months ago, a suggestion was made that the Oakland Art Association might consider managing the art in the Alameda County Law Library Gallery for more than the one show a year as we have been. After some thought and discussion, the OAA board agreed to assume responsibility for the Venue from July 1st through Decem-

ber 31st 2017 and we will produce two juried OAA shows during that time as well as a couple "Satellite" style shows featuring just a few artists at a time. The board is still considering the possibilities, but the Satellite show option could be expanded to include art from schools as well as other community art groups in general. Hopefully this management

arrangement will work well for everyone involved, and will extend into 2018 and beyond. The Library is a first class venue with lots of light and foot traffic -- it gives OAA the opportunity to expand member shows as well as new ways to promote the visual arts in our community. (Remember our Strategic Plan? See the back page.)

2017 Solo Show Schedule:

Exhibit Rules

RECEIVING: Friday December 9th, 2016 from 10 AM until 11AM at the Presbyterian Church, 4101 Park Blvd., Oakland. Enter parking lot from Hampel Street.

JUROR: Anne Austin Curator/Coordinator San Pablo Art Gallery

ACCEPTED WORKS: Pick up on a date in March 2017 to be announced at the Presbyterian Church.

ENTRIES: Up to 2 entries will be accepted per member. Entries will be two dimensional; 12"x 12" min. and 36"x 36" max. - nominal size including mats.

Artworks depicting iconic scenes of San Francisco are not appropriate for this venue! If entered, artwork in this category may be rejected at the sole discretion of the show chairman.

Because only 7 "large" (i.e. over 24"X30") works can be displayed in the show space, only the first 7 "large" pieces will be accepted, unless specifically allowed by the Show Chair.

Works restricted to original work – no class work or copies. Nudes and political statements are not accepted (venue requirement). All work must be for sale. The Chamber reserves the right to reject any work from the show for any reason.

Any work shown at a Chamber of Commerce Show **prior to** December 2012 may be shown again at this show. Any work having won a cash award in any OAA show is not eligible to receive another cash award but may receive a merit award.

To be entered as a single work, any grouping of 2 or more works must be mounted within a single frame which meets the overall size requirements.

ENTRY FEE: \$8.00 per entry.

FRAMING: No wide (may not exceed 3") or elaborate frames will be accepted.

Mats must be clean and well cut and frames must be clean, sturdy and no protruding screw eyes or hangers will be allowed.

Works larger than 24" x 30" (if covered) must be under plastic instead of glass.

Entry Forms : Must be filled out completely and affixed to the upper left hand corner on the back of the entry.

PLEASE TYPE OR PRINT LEGIBLY!

AWARDS: First award \$100; Second award \$50; Third award \$25. Merit awards are given at the discretion of the Juror.

INSURANCE: A waiver must be signed on receiving day.

SALES:

All sales made during the show and/or 30days following the close of the show (if the work was seen by the buyer at the show) will be handled by the Sales Chairman Tina Nelson rixin2@aol.com or 925 256-6849.

OAA policy is that no change will be made in the price (in connection with this show) after the work is accepted. The artist agrees that 30% of the sale price will be taken as a contribution to OAA. Sales tax of 9% will be added to all sales.

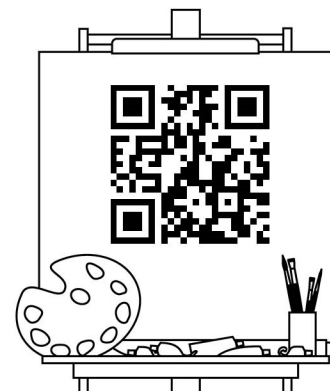
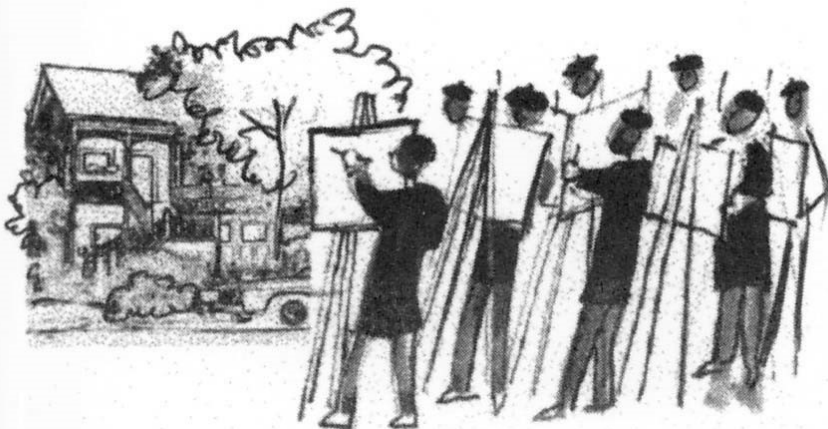
