CHAIR: Stan Cohen

RECEIVING: Friday, April 28, between 1pm and 3 pm at Park Blvd Presbyterian Church 4101 Park Blvd. Oakland, corner of Hempel. Enter parking lot on Hempel.

Juror: to be announced

NON-ACCEPTED: Must be picked up at church between 4 and 5 pm on April 28th. Artists will be called.

ACCEPTED WORKS: Pick up Wednesday, May 31, between 1pm and 3 pm, at Park Blvd Presbyterian Church.

ENTRIES: All 2 dimensional media, Minimum Size 9"x 12", Maximum Size 16"x 20"

Original work only; no copies or class work. Nudes or Political Statements not accepted. All work must be for sale. Three works may be entered, three accepted.

ENTRY FEE: \$8 per entry

FRAMING: No wide or elaborate frames. No protruding screw eyes or hardware. Mats must be clean and well cut. Frames must be neat and sturdy. Works on paper must be under Plastic or Glass.

LABELS: Labels must be filled in completely and affixed to upper left corner on back of entry. Please type or print clearly.

AWARDS: First Award: \$100, Second: \$50, Third: \$25. Merit Awards at discretion of Juror.

INSURANCE: Signed Waiver must be on file or signed at Receiving.

SALES: Handled by Stan Cohen (533-3003). All sales made during show and for 30 days after close, if seen at show, must comply with OAA Policy: "no change in price". 30% of sale is contributed to OAA. 8.5% Sales Tax must be added to price.
