Oakland Art Association Giving Program for our Educational Fund:

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Editors Note: During last December's Board Meeting it was unanimously decided to earmark \$4,500 of our cash reserve to support Art Education in our communities going forward. It was also decided that going forward OAA will put all commissions from sales of your art toward the same Art Education fund (and you can claim the 30% commission as a tax deductible donation). The mission of OAA is evolving: first to provide public venues for our members to show and sell their art, but also to dedicate our resources to Art Education.

Art Association's (OAA) Educational Fund. This program is an integral part of OAA and has already made a difference at Grass Valley Elementary School, our first recipient.

During the 2015 and 2016 school year, OAA, working through the Oakland Unified School District, was able to help Art Teacher Kristen Vetterlein's program at Grass Valley Elementary School in Oakland. Working with almost no budget at all, Ms. Vetterlein developed an outstanding program that included all the students at the school. OAA provided the funds to buy art supplies. OAA also contributed in non-monetary ways, donating art supplies, including Grass Valley student's art in a number of juried shows, and

making about 20 display boards for Grass Valley. OAA is looking for other worthy projects to support now and in the future.

There are three ways you can donate to support these kinds of projects. Every year when you renew your membership, you can provide an additional amount designated for the educational fund. You can also contribute to the fund at any time by sending a check to OAA Treasurer Hallie Strock. Additionally, you may include OAA in your estate planning. Given that OAA is a nonprofit organization, you will receive tax deduction. No matter how you may decide to donate, your contributions will support young artists now and in the future.

You now can contribute to supporting art educational projects in schools and with nonprofit organizations through the Oakland

- Have you heard about the two 3-hour (10:00 AM to 1:00 PM and 6:30 to 9:30 PM) "**live model**" **painting sessions every Tuesday at "Firehouse North"** (1790 Shattuck Ave) in Berkeley? The morning group usually has short poses with a nude model and the evening group (**hosted by OAA member Iris Saber**) has one long pose, usually clothed. The cost is \$20 per session, and all media and levels of experience are welcome.

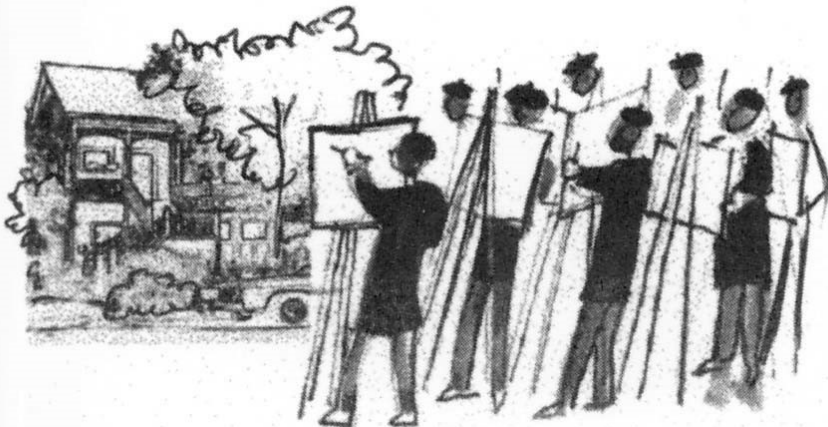

Because only 7 "large" (i.e. over 24"X30") works can be displayed in the show space, only the first 7 "large" pieces will be accepted, unless specifically allowed by the Show Chair.

Works restricted to original work – no class work or copies. Nudes and political statements are not accepted (venue requirement). All work must be for sale. The Chamber reserves the right to reject any work from the show for any reason.

Any work shown at a Chamber of Commerce Show **prior to** December 2012 may be shown again at this show. Any work having won a cash award in any OAA show is not eligible to receive another cash award but may receive a merit award.

To be entered as a single work, any grouping of 2 or more works must be mounted within a single frame which meets the overall size requirements.
