ACCEPTED WORKS: Pickup Sunday June 30th at the Library between 10:00 am and 11:30 am at the rear entrance.

ENTRIES:

Two dimensional work; 36"x 40" maximum (or 1440 square inches) including frames. (No minimum size)

Up to 3 entries submitted/accepted per member, but only 1 may be "large" (i.e. over 1000 square inches").

Works restricted to original work – no class work or copies.

Nudes and political statements are not accepted (venue requirement).

All work must be for sale.

Transportation of artwork to and from the library is the responsibility of the artist.

All work having won cash awards in any OAA show are not eligible to receive another cash award, but may receive a merit award.

To be entered as a single work, any grouping of 2 or more works must be mounted within a single frame which meets the overall size requirements.

ENTRY FEE: \$8.00 per entry.

FRAMING:

No wide (may not exceed 3") or elaborate frames will be accepted.

Mats must be clean and well cut.

Frames must be clean, sturdy and no protruding screw eyes or hangers will be allowed.

Works larger than 24" x 30" (if covered) must be under plastic instead of glass.

LABELS: Must be filled out completely and affixed to the upper left hand corner on the back of the entry.

AWARDS: First award \$125; Second award \$75; Third award \$50. Merit awards are given at the discretion of the Juror.

INSURANCE: A waiver must be signed on receiving day.

RECEPTION: Wednesday June 5th 6:30pm until 8pm. This event will be in the meeting room on the first floor beside the café.

SALES: All sales made during the show and/or 30 days following the close of the show (if the work was seen by the buyer at the show) will be handled by the Sales Chair Tina Nelson 925 256-6849.

OAA policy is that no change will be made in the price (in connection with this show) after the work is accepted.

The artist agrees that 30% of the sale price will be taken as a contribution to OAA.

Sales tax of 9% will be added to all sales.

ACCEPTED WORKS: Pick up at the Presbyterian Church on September 6th between 10 AM and 11 AM.

ENTRIES: Up to 2 entries will be accepted per member. Entries will be two dimensional; 12"x 12" min. and 36"x 36" max. - nominal size including mats.

Artworks depicting iconic scenes of San Francisco are not appropriate for this venue! If entered, artwork in this category may be rejected at the sole discretion of the show chairman.

Because only 7 "large" (i.e. over 24"X30") works can be displayed in the show space, only the first 7 "large" pieces will be accepted, unless specifically allowed by the Show Chair.

Works restricted to original work – no class work or copies. Nudes and political statements are not accepted (venue requirement). All work must be for sale. The Chamber reserves the right to reject any work from the show for any reason.

Any work shown at a Chamber of Commerce Show **prior to** August 2010 may be shown again at this show. Any work having won a cash award in any OAA show is not eligible to receive another cash award but may receive a merit award.

To be entered as a single work, any grouping of 2 or more works must be mounted within a single frame which meets the overall size requirements.

ENTRY FEE: \$8.00 per entry.

FRAMING: No wide (may not exceed 3") or elaborate frames will be accepted.

Mats must be clean and well cut and frames must be clean, sturdy and no protruding screw eyes or hangers will be allowed.

Sadly we report the passing of Patricia N. Barkas of El Sobrante. Pat was a longtime resident of the West County. Born at Alta Bates Hospital in Berkeley to Ralph and Florence Nelson, and sister to Christina, Pat attended Albany schools and subsequently U.C. Davis and U.C. Berkeley. Pat had an abiding passion for many media of art and produced many and varied works. She competed in numerous local art competitions, and received many

awards.

Pat's professional career was with (the then) Pacific Telephone, where she excelled as a Copy Service Artist for the Yellow Pages and subsequently to Yellow Pages advertisement sales and management. In sales she was honored once as the single best telephone sales representative in the State of California. Pat retired in 2000, but continued with her artwork. Pat was well traveled, visiting Europe several times, New Zealand and Australia and many other warm tropical destinations.

Pat is survived by her husband, Victor Barkas, and their two dogs, Chelsey and Charlie of El Sobrante. Pat did not have children, but her life was filled with numerous, cherished friends, relatives and pets. 

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
