MTC Show set for January

The Metropolitan Transportation Commission has invited Oakland Art Association to show from January 15 to April 15, 2009. The Show Rules will differ from previous shows and may be easier in some ways and more challenging in other ways.

The challenge is that the gallery is large (up to 60 pieces, depending on size,) and our last show there did not generate enough work to fill the space.

This time we will ask artists to submit a GROUP of 4 to 8 works rather than the usual one or two.

Minimum size: 18" x 24" including frame. No nudes, no "traditional" still life.

To make the selection process easier, artists will send good quality 4x6" photos of art work for the selection juror to review.

Only those pieces selected will need to be physically delivered to the MTC Building.

All photos will be returned to artists after the selection. Some images may be used in publicity for the show.

A full Show Rules sheet will be printed in the newsletter later this fall, but it is not too early to photograph the work that you may want to enter. Color prints 4x6" available at any pharmacy or 1 hour photo shop are OK. (note: see news on page 3) Call 533-3003 for further information.

Exhibit Rules**CHAIR:** John Mallon**RECEIVING:** Friday, September 12, 2008 from 10 AM until 12 noon at the Presbyterian Church, 4101 Park Blvd., Oakland. Enter parking lot from Hampel Street.**JUROR:** Patricia Davis (<http://www.patriciadavisfineart.com/>)**ACCEPTED WORKS:** Pick up at the Presbyterian Church on Friday November 14, 2008 between 10 AM and 12 noon.**ENTRIES:** Entries will be two dimensional; 16"x 20" min. and 36"x 36" max. Only 1 entry accepted per member.

Artworks depicting iconic scenes of San Francisco are not appropriate for this venue! If entered, artwork in this category may be rejected at the sole discretion of the show chairman.

Because only 7 "large" (i.e. over 24"X30") works can be displayed in the show space, only the first 7 "large" pieces will be accepted, unless specifically allowed by the Show Chair.

Works restricted to original work – no class work or copies.

Nudes and political statements are not accepted (venue requirement).

All work must be for sale.

The Chamber reserves the right to reject any work from the show for any reason.

Any work shown at a Chamber of Commerce Show **prior to** September 2005 may be shown again at this show. Any work having won a cash award in any OAA show is not eligible to receive another cash award but may receive a merit award.

To be entered as a single work, any grouping of 2 or more works must be mounted within a single frame which meets the overall size requirements.

ENTRY FEE: \$8.00 per entry.**FRAMING:** No wide (may not exceed 3") or elaborate frames will be accepted.

Mats must be clean and well cut and frames must be clean, sturdy and no protruding screw eyes or hangers will be allowed.

Works larger than 24" x 30" (if covered) must be under plastic instead of glass.

LABELS: Must be filled out completely and affixed to the upper left hand corner on the back of the entry.**PLEASE TYPE OR PRINT LEGIBLY!****AWARDS:** First award \$100; Second award \$50; Third award \$25. Merit awards are given at the discretion of the Juror.**INSURANCE:** A waiver must be signed on receiving day.**SALES:**

All sales made during the show and/or 30days following the close of the show (if the work was seen by the buyer at the show) will be handled by the Sales Chairman Stan Cohen 510 533-3003.

OAA policy is that no change will be made in the price (in connection with this show) after the work is accepted.

The artist agrees that 30% of the sale price will be taken as a contribution to OAA.

Sales tax of 8.75% will be added to all sales.
